

Early Years Pupil Premium - Extra funding to support your child at nursery

The Early Years Pupil Premium provides an extra 53p per hour for three and four year old children whose parents are in receipt of certain benefits or who have been in care or adopted from care. **This means an extra £302 a year for each child** taking up the full 570 hours funded entitlement to early education.

This additional money could make a significant difference, enhancing the quality of the early year's education that we provide for your child. We use this money in a variety of ways and some are detailed below:

- **Discounts on school trips**
- **Play bags to take home**
- **Enhanced training for staff**

When you complete your orange form if you can read the eligibility criteria, complete as soon as possible and return to the office.

A child will be eligible for the Early Years Pupil Premium if their parents are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits or credits. **Please circle the relevant benefit**

- None of the following apply
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, but not Working Tax Credit, with an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

Your child has

- Left care through Special Guardianship
- Been or is subject to a child arrangement order (formerly known as residence order)

Your child has:

- Been Looked After by the local authority for at least one day, if your child qualifies on this basis you need take no further action as we will identify the children concerned and the funding will be managed by the Virtual School Team at WCC
